Attention Port of Nome Users:

Effective July 10, 2021, the harbor launch ramp ('Barge Ramp') will be undergoing repairs and unavailable for use until the project is complete, sometime between $September\ 15^{th}$ - 30^{th} .

All vessels needing use of the Barge Ramp to launch or haul out during the 2021 season must submit a current Haul Out / Launch User Agreement to the Port Office for the Harbormaster's or Port Director's approval prior to ramp use. All vessels must be clear of the launch ramp by July 9th and allow the contractor sufficient working area to complete the project.

Alternate launch / haul out locations may be made available while the launch ramp is offline. Users needing an alternate location during the ramp closure, should contact the Harbormaster to discuss vessel size, configuration
