Nome SDEU applied for and was granted a search warrant for the persons of Tuzroyluke and Casa-dos-Lane as well as any bags belonging to Tuz-royluke and Casada page A coverde page A rovluke and Casados-Lane. A second search arrant was obtained for an internal body scan of

Tuzroyluke. Investigative efforts by Nome SDEU and AST led to the seizure of 27.2 grams of cocaine from Ca-sados-Lane and 59.3 grams of cocaine from Tuzrovluke. All of the cocaine seized had been secreted internally within Casados-Lane and Tuz-

Secreted Internary when outputs royluke. One ounce of cocaine (28 grams) is sold in An-chorage for approximately \$1,200; cocaine is sold in Kotzebue for approximately \$150 per gram. Therefore, the approximate Kotzebue street value of the 86 grams (3 ounces) of cocaine seized from Casados-Lane and Tuzroyluke is \$12,900. The amounts seized in this case are consistent with the distribution of narcotics rather than just personal

Tuzrovluke and Casados-Lane were subsequently arrested, and each charged with Misconduct In-volving Controlled Substances in the third degree; they were remanded at the Anvil Mountain Correc-tional Center.


