Kakoona was charged with the following: Three counts of Sexual Abuse of a Minor

in the 2nd Degree, One count of Sexual Abuse of a Minor in the 3rd Degree, Seven counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Seven counts of Possession of Child Sexual Abuse Material, Seven counts of Distribution of Child Sexual Abuse Material, One count of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, Seven counts of Unlawful Contact and Four

counts of Failure to Register as a Sex Offender.
